

Subject: **Mile High Flood District Responsibilities & Information**

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Mile High Flood District is responsible for all streams in Colorado including Dutch Creek Stream on Leawood Parks.

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Key points:

1. July 25 Mile High added Raccoon Creek erosion and Beaver dam projects to their maintenance list. Board to keep eye on dams impacts on stream in the meantime.
2. Even after projects are on the docket, securing a firm start date from Jefferson County or MHFD can be challenging. A **2026 start date for the Beaver Dam project cannot be guaranteed** due to the volume of other district-wide issues.
3. Not all issues will be taken on by Jefferson County or MHFD. For example, **seep-willow growth in Dutch Creek above Kendall St. was declined** as a maintenance item.
4. **Project Status Tracking:** Once submitted and approved, projects will be added to the **MHFD Confluence website** (<https://confluence.mhfd.org/map>). This typically happens around the **end of August**. Future board members can use this link to check project status.
