


Q1 Are you a resident in the Park District (Leawood, Country Farms, Vintage Reserve)?



Q2 If you answered yes to 1, what community do you live in?



Q3 What is your age?



Q4 If you usually bring children to the parks, please indicate their age group(s)



Q5 How often do you use the Parks"



Q6 Which Park do you most use?






